

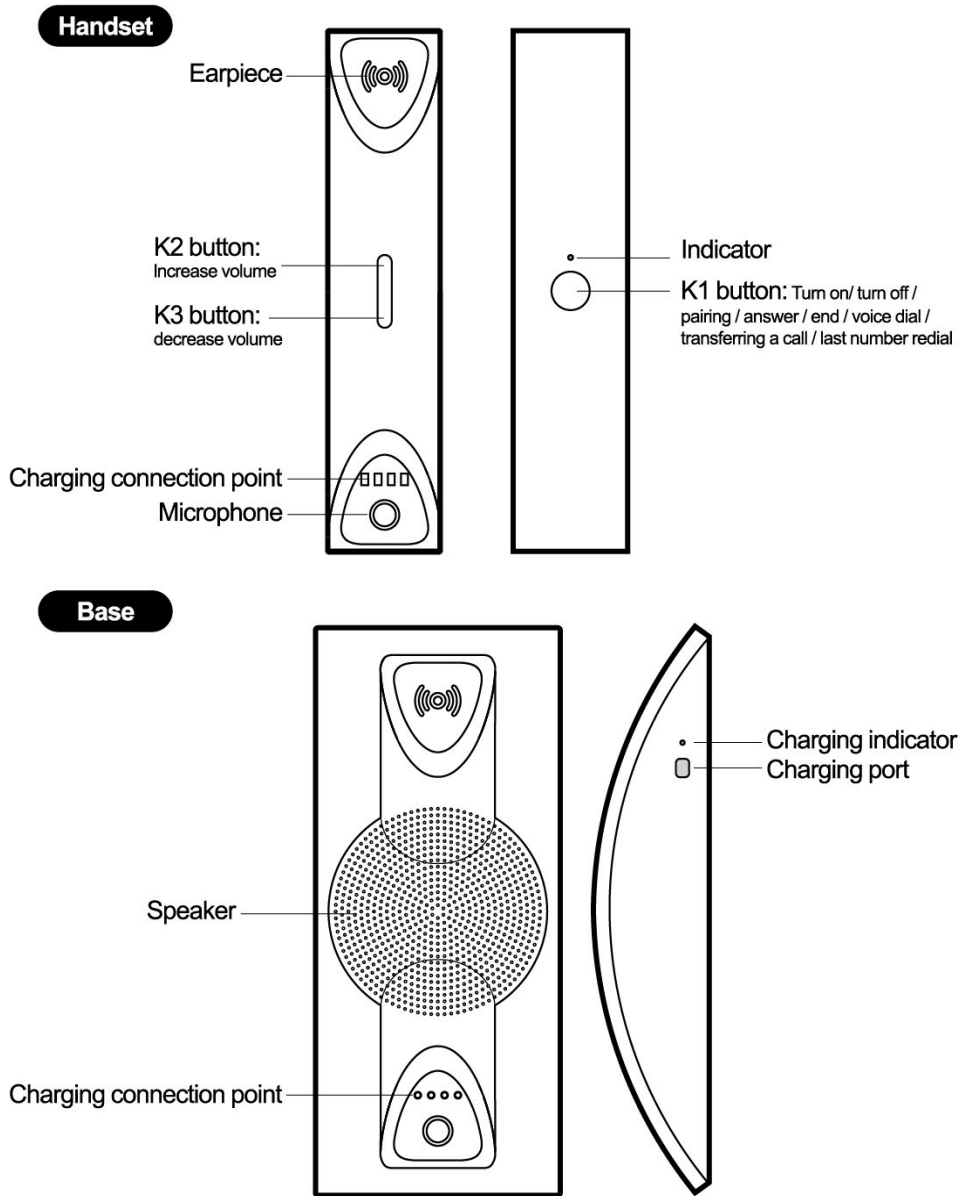

LOCATION OF CONTROLS

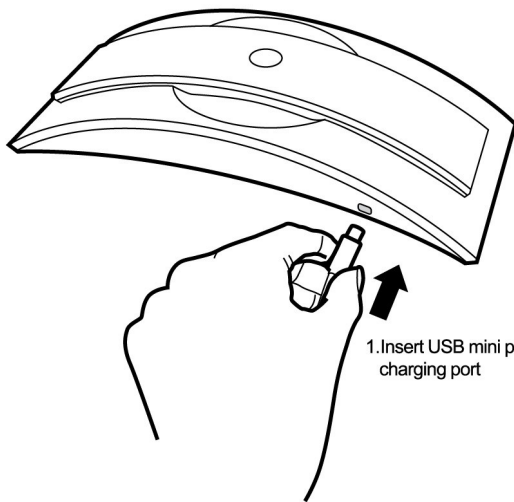


PLEASE READ THE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY before using your new handset.

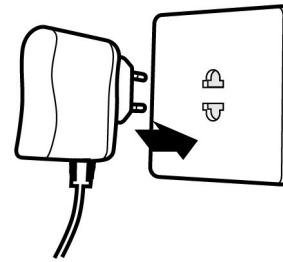
This product was designed and manufactured to meet strict quality and safety standards, bring you joy, decrease noise, eliminate phone radiation and improve call comfort.

POWER CONNECTION

The headset contains a rechargeable battery. When recharging, the red indicator will turn on, then when fully charged it will turn blue. We highly recommend you full charge the battery before using the headset for the first time.



1. Insert USB mini port into the charging port



2. Plug the USB cable into a computer or into a AC socket through a DC adaptor

Charging the headset

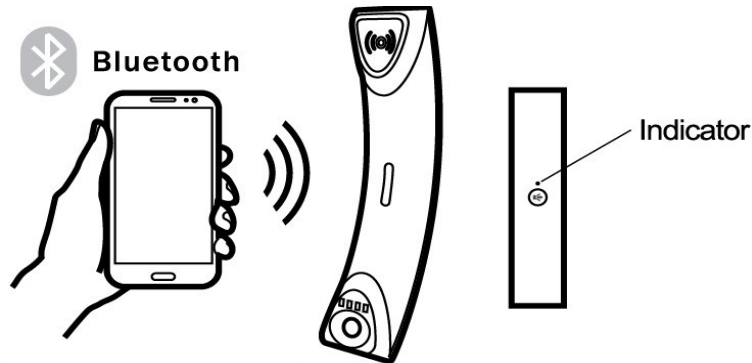
1. Please keep the headset on the base all the time, ensuring a good connection between the two charging points of the headset and the base.
2. When charging, the red indicators on the headset and base will flash. When fully charged, the indicator will turn blue on the headset and green on the base.

NOTES

- When the headset is low in battery, the headset indicator will flash red.
- The headset will be fully charged after about 1-2 hours of charging.
- Do not attempt to charge the headset with anything other than the USB cable provided. Using unauthorized USB cables may damage the headset.
- The headset cannot be used while charging.
- Avoid storage at high temperatures (above 60°C) such as inside a hot vehicle or in direct sunlight.
- Do not expose the headset or any of its components to rain or other liquids.

Bluetooth pairing

Before using your headset for the first time, you must pair it with your Bluetooth enabled phone.



Pairing

- Ensure that the headset is off and the mobile phone Bluetooth setting is enabled.
- Press and hold the K1 button for about 4 seconds until the indicator light alternately flashes blue and red. At this point, the headset is in pairing mode.
- Set your Bluetooth phone to discover the headset by following your phone guide. Typically, the steps involve going to a “setup”, “connect” or “Bluetooth” menu on your phone and then selecting the option to discover Bluetooth devices.
- Your Bluetooth mobile phone will find the “DX-3312” headset and ask if you want to pair with it. Confirm this by pressing the “YES” or “OK” key.
- If you need to enter a password or PIN code, please enter “0000” (four zeroes) then press the “YES” or “OK” key. Once the blue indicator flashes twice instead of blue and red, your headset has been connected successfully to your phone.
- Note: if the pairing cannot be completed within 90 seconds in pairing mode, please repeat the process again to try to pair them.

Simple pairing

- Once your headset is under pairing mode, it will search for the nearest Bluetooth devices, such as your mobile phone automatically.
- Your Bluetooth mobile phone will indicate “DX-3312” headset and ask if you want to pair with it. Confirm this by pressing the “YES” or “OK” button.
- If you need to enter a password or PIN code, please enter “0000” (four zeroes) then press the “YES” or “OK” key. Once the blue indicator flashes twice instead of blue and red, your headset has been connected successfully to your phone.
- Note: if the Bluetooth version on your mobile phone is V2.1 or above, you will not need to enter the password or PIN during the pairing process.

Pairing your headset with two mobile phones (multipoint connecting)

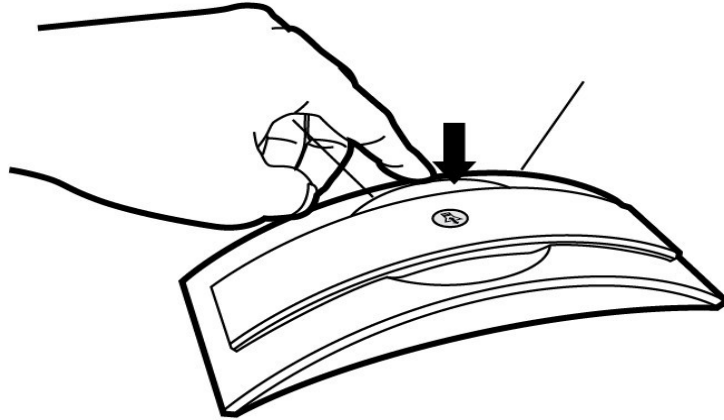
- The headset supports a multipoint function to allow simultaneous pairing of the headset with two mobile phones.
- Follow the pairing procedure as instructed in the “pairing” section to pair the headset with the first mobile phone.
- Turn off the headset.
- Repeat the same pairing procedure on the second mobile phone.
- On the first mobile phone's menu, activate the Bluetooth connection with the headset.

Specifications

- Bluetooth compliance: Bluetooth version 3.0 specifications, Class II
- Support Bluetooth headset & hands-free profiles
- Multipoint profile: connect with two Bluetooth devices at the same time
- Operating range: up to 30 feet (10 metres)
- Frequency: 2.40 – 2.48GHz
- Talk time: up to 10 hours
- Standby time: up to 240 hours

Operating Instructions

When pairing is successful, press the K1 button to answer an incoming call through the speaker on the base and outer microphone. Press the K1 button again to disconnect the call. In hands-free mode, picking up the headset will shift the call to the headset.



To turn the headset on/off

- Turn on: press and hold the K1 button for about 2 seconds. The blue indicator on the headset will flash 3 times rapidly. The headset is now on.
- Turn off: press and hold the K1 button for about 2 seconds. The red indicator on the headset will flash 5 times rapidly. The headset is now off.
- When the blue indicator flashes red during standby mode, it means the headset is low on battery and needs to be recharged soon.

Making a call

- Dial the number on the keypad or select the contact name from the contact list on your mobile phone.
- Press the phone's "send/call" key.

Voice dialling

- Please ensure your mobile phone supports the voice dialling function and the voice tag is assigned for this feature.
- Quickly press the K1 button once, then you will hear the voice-activation tone. Say the name of the person you wish to call.
- Quickly press the K1 button again to stop dialling.

Ending a call

- Press the K1 button during the call or end the call from your mobile phone keypad.

Answering a call

- Press the K1 button to receive an incoming call.

Last number dialling

- Press the K1 button twice to make the last number redial.
- Note: depending on your phone type, the actual operation may vary.

Rejecting an incoming call

- Press and hold the K2 and K3 buttons for 2 seconds, then release after you hear the voice activation tone.

Adjusting the volume

- Press the K2 button to increase the volume level and press the K3 button to decrease the volume level.

Transferring a call

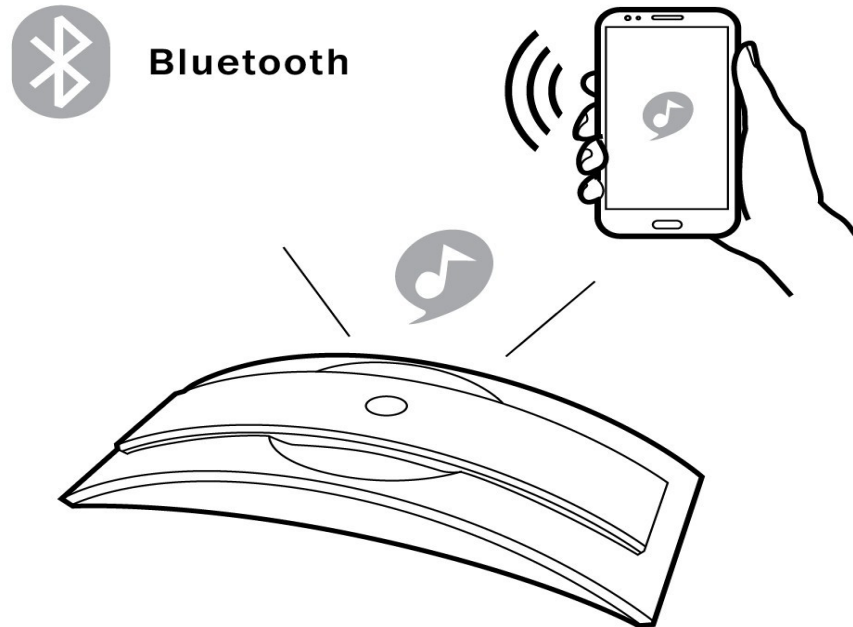
- Headset to phone: press and hold the K1 button for 3 seconds when you are on a phone call. Then, the phone call will be transferred to your phone.
- Phone to headset: press and hold the K1 button for 3 seconds when you are on a phone call. Then, the phone call will be transferred to the headset.
- Note: for different mobile phone settings, you may only be able to transfer a call by pressing the mobile phone's keypad. Depending on your phone, the actual operation method may vary.

Muting the microphone

- You can put a call on hold by muting the microphone. To turn on/off the muting microphone function, press the K2 and K3 buttons at the same time.

Speaker

The product base is a speaker, so you can stream music directly from your Bluetooth devices.



Operating procedures

- Complete the pairing as described in the above pairing procedures.
- Put the headset onto the base, making sure a good connection between the charging points is established.
- Play and control the music via the music player in your device (mobile phone, iPad etc..)
