



## Solar Powered LED Gutter Lights KALGHTGUT2A Quick Start Guide

Read all instructions carefully before assembly and installation.  
Before first use, remove the protective film from the solar panels.

### Charging and operation

1. Turn the switch to “ON”. The switch is located on the bottom base of the solar panels.
2. Charge the solar products by placing them under direct sunlight for at least 8 hours.
3. The lights will work automatically when the switches are in the “ON” position, charging automatically under direct sunshine and then illuminating at night.

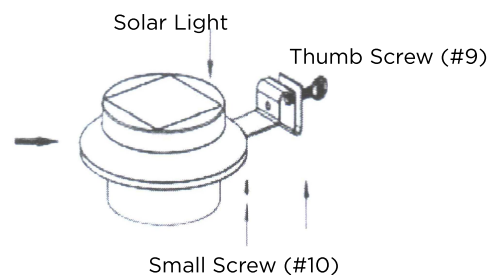
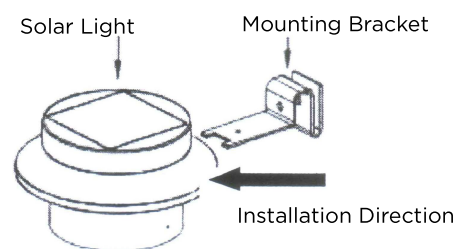
Note: in order to verify that the unit is correctly switched to the “ON” position, simply place your hand over the solar panel. The light itself should turn on.

### Important Notes

- Keep the solar panels clean.
- If the solar product does not light up after 8-12 months of use, the rechargeable batteries may need replacing. (One x 1.2v 600Mah, Ni-MH AA battery should be used.)
- Exercise caution when replacing the batteries. Open the battery casing to replace the old battery with a new one. The spent batteries should be recycled or disposed of properly. Do not dispose of batteries in household waste.

### Assembly Instructions

1. Insert the mounting bracket into the solar light case, and secure it with a small screw (#10), using a small Philips Head screwdriver (screwdriver not included).
2. Install the mounting bracket onto the gutter, and secure with a thumb screw (#9).
