Waterproof Roof Top Cargo Bag

Quick Start Guide

Safety and Warnings

- INSPECT for signs of wear and damage BEFORE each use. DO NOT use if worn or damaged.
- DO NOT EXCEED your vehicle's rated roof capacity. Consult the owner's manual for your vehicle.
- DO NOT use your Cargo Bag to transport people, animals or flammable liquids.
- Check local and state laws governing projection of objects beyond the perimeter of a vehicle. Be aware of the width and height of your cargo as low branches, bridges, and parking garages can pose a hazard.

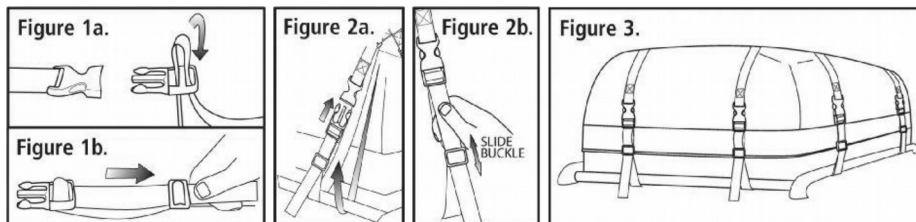
NOTE: Always face the side with no zipper towards the FRONT of the vehicle.

Installation

Roof carrier bags are easy to install on any car, van or SUV with rack, no tools needed:

1. Check that there is no debris and the roof is clean.
2. Place bag on vehicle roof rack between the side rails and cross bars.

Loading



1. Unzip the bag and load cargo into the bag. Place heavy, large objects in first. This may require a partner to help you. Load lighter items on the top, creating a compact load. Store in plastic bags for extra protection from condensation.
2. Close the zipper and fold the flap to completely cover the entire zipper and secure using hook and loop fasteners. Make sure the zipper pulls are not on top of the hook and loop material, as this will prevent a secure hold.
3. Feed the straps through the strap holder locations. Loop both ends of each strap under either a side rail or a cross bar. Engage the buckles.
4. Alternate tightening both ends of each strap until the Cargo Bag is secure. Tie off excess strap length to prevent the straps from flapping while driving.
5. CHECK the cargo bag is **SECURE**. If cargo bag is not secure, **DO NOT USE**. Remember the cargo can shift on the cross bars or the bag can loosen during travel. Readjust as needed. If movement continues, stop use.
