









KOMODO™ **Breathe Easy Snorkel** **KDEYBRSNLLA / KDEYBRSNLSA**

Accessories

	O ring: this is used to create a seal and stop leaking. If an O ring breaks or goes missing, a spare is provided. The O rings can be replaced by the user.
	Valve: there are 3 x valve assemblies inside the mask. 1 piece at the side of the mouth and 1 piece in the chin piece.
	Removable Camera Mount: the mount can be attached to the top of the snorkel, which can then have an action camera mounted onto it.
	Nut and Screw Set: these are included to use to attach a GoPro to the mount.

Usage

- Assemble the breathing tube head into the top of the mask, making sure it is securely attached.
- Completely loosen both sides of the end headband. Lift the headband up, then rest your chin into the bottom of the mask.
- Pull the headband until it is comfortably strapped around the back of your head. The mask should press against your face and fit snugly.
- Tighten the bottom of the headband tightly, keeping both sides the same. Make sure the mask seals properly.
- If desired, you can attach an Action Camera to the top of the mask using the screws and nut.

Usage Tips

- Make sure the rubber O ring is on the base where the tube connection is. This will ensure a tight fit with no leaks.
- Don't be afraid to push down hard on the tube, or pull hard to remove it. It will not break.
- Putting the mask on incorrectly will cause water to leak in from either your chin or your forehead. If this occurs, adjust the straps to make the mask fit tighter.
- It is suggested that you use the mask in water temperatures between 18°C - 45°C.
 Note: if the water is over 40°C, the mask will fog up still. If the fogging up is heavy, please double check to ensure that the mask is sealed properly.

Warnings

- It is recommended that use is only by a competent individual swimmer.
- Do not snorkel alone. Always have a companion.
- Do not snorkel in high waves or rapid currents.
- Not suitable for free diving or intensive swimming.
- Practice at first in a shallow area of the beach or in a pool.
- No suitable for children under 3 years of age due to small parts. CHOKING HAZARD.
- Not to be worn outside of the water.
- Rinse the mask clean with fresh tap water after each use. Do not use soaps or detergents.
- After rinsing, let the mask hang in the shade to air dry.
- Do not expose the mask to direct sunlight for extended periods of time.
- Do not wipe the viewing window section with a towel. Use an eyeglass cleaning cloth.
- Do not press or bang mask against hard surfaces.
