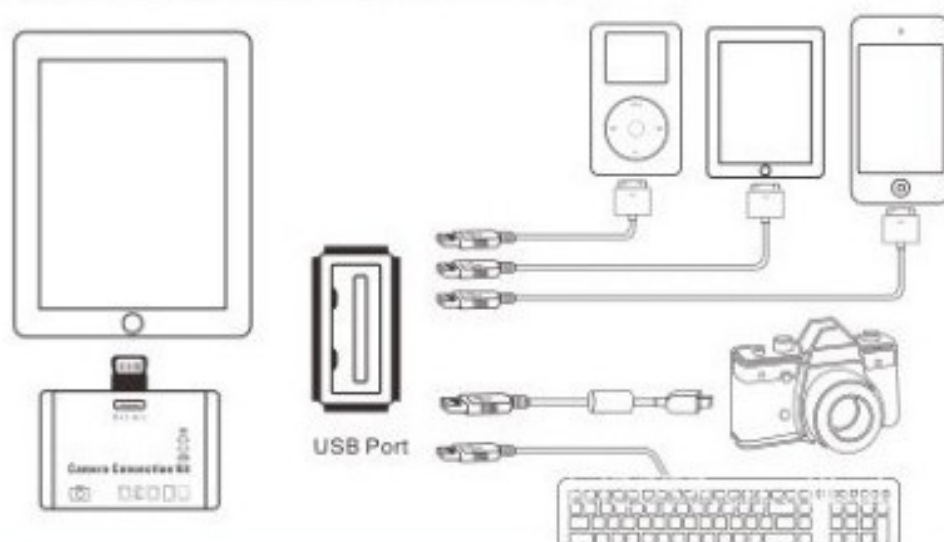
## 5-in-1 iPad 4/iPad Mini Camera Connection Kit

### Introduction

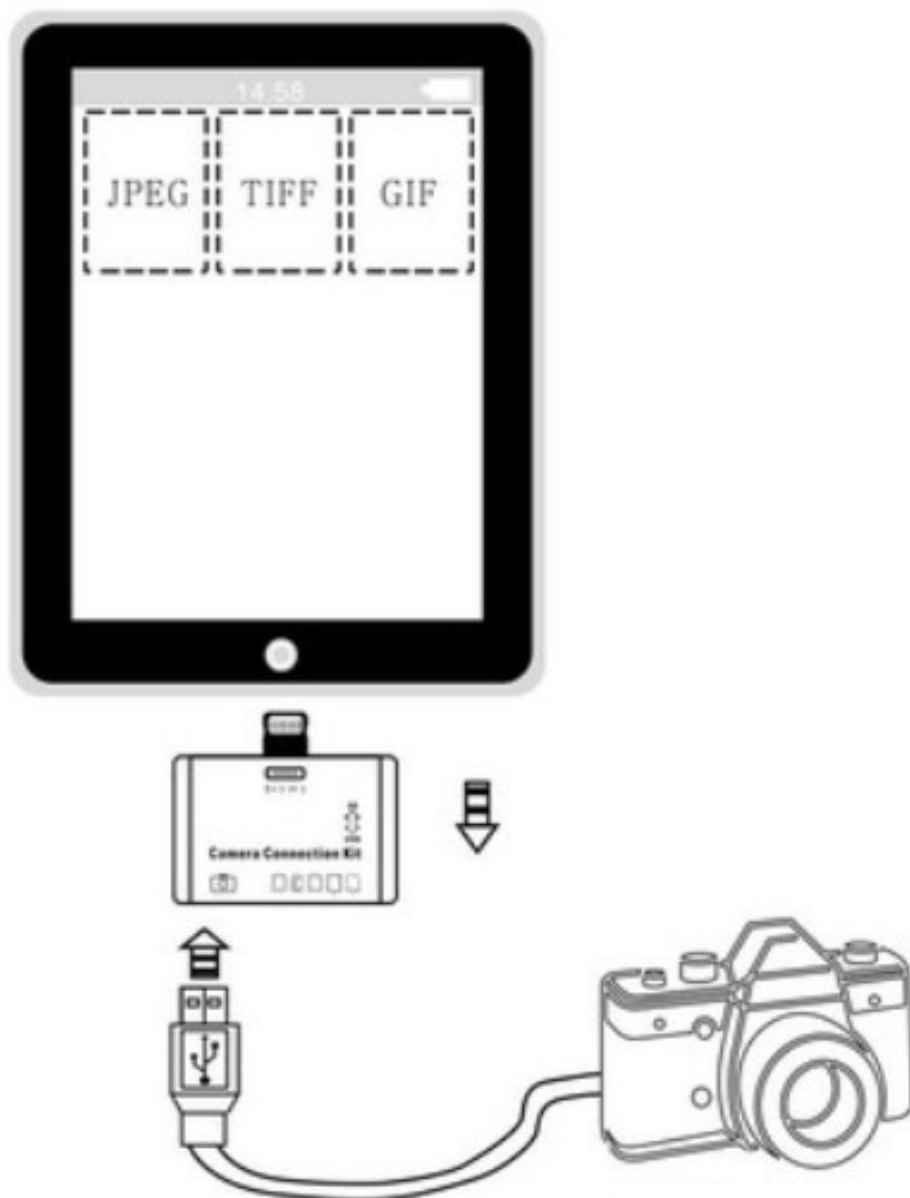
With the iPad 4 / iPad Mini camera connection kit, you can easily download photos and videos from your digital camera to your iPad and share them with your family and friends.

The kit has two means of connection, each with a different interface. The device features a USB port enabling connection via USB. Note: whilst 3G Phones aren't supported, external keyboards and similar devices will be compatible.

The kit also enables the use of SDHC, MS DUIO, MMC, M2 and T-Flash cards with its card readers. Your iPad will automatically open photos stored on your cards and/or USB devices once connected.



Photos and videos stored within the camera's internal/external memory can be uploaded to the iPad directly via USB connection. Using a USB cable, connect your camera with the camera connection kit device. Next, ensure the camera connection kit device is connected to the iPad. The iPad should detect the camera within seconds, allowing you to browse your files.



Alternatively, you may remove your media/external memory from the camera, i.e. a SDHC/MS/MCC card. Once the card has been removed from the camera, insert it directly into the specific slot as indicated on the camera connection kit. Once you have inserted the media, ensure the camera connection kit device is connected to the iPad. The connection should be recognised in a matter of seconds.



If you are unable to see your photos/videos, please check which formats your iPad can support. Currently, the iPad mini supports JPEG, TIFF and GIF Standard formatted images. It also supports MP4 and MOV format video files. If your photos/videos are in other formats, please convert them into one of the accepted formats as listed above.
